COLLEGE TRANSPORT

St John's Regional College provides a variety of transport options to assist parents in getting their students to school. Bus travel arrangements are a combination of Private School Charters and Dedicated School Runs operated by Public Transport Victoria.

The College is pleased to advise that they have partnered with Crown Coaches for the provision of the Private School Charters for 2022 and beyond. Crown are a locally based bus company that will offer students with comfortable, state of the art buses for their transport to and from school.



If you choose to use the **Charter Bus Program**, there is an annual contribution of \$1,180 which will be charged to your bus fee account. The timetables are devised to ensure cost-effectiveness with optimum student participation and geographical limitations.

To indicate your need to use the Charter Bus Program, you must book your student on the bus and numbers are limited.

How to Book

Bookings operate on a first in basis via Trybooking and there is no cost to book

To be allocated a bus service in 2022, please complete the following steps:

1. Work out the Bus Service that best suit your needs
2. Apply for a bus place via the relevant Trybooking Link for your preferred service for each student individually

You will be asked to enter the following information on your preferred bus:

- Student Name
- Year Level in 2022
- Homeroom (select unknown if not sure)
- Address

If the bus is already full, please add your child's name on the waiting list.

Further Information

CHARTER BUS SERVICE IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Bus fees are charged annually and will be invoiced separately to your tuition fees.
- The College reserves the right to alter routes/times as the need arises.

Behaviour on buses:

- Use appropriate language not offensive or racist language.
- Fighting, spitting, feet on seats, throwing things in or from the bus is not permitted.
- No eating or drinking (other than water) – unless for medical reasons.
- No drug use or alcohol consumption is allowed.
- Do not push or shove other people.
- Do not bully or harass other passengers or the driver.
- Avoid attracting the attention of the driver except in the case of emergency.
- Do not play music at such volume that it may distract the bus driver or other passengers.

Safety on and near buses:

- Obey reasonable directions from the driver (e.g., where to sit or to remain in the bus).
- Remain in your seat – do not move around the bus unnecessarily.
- Keep bags and other items clear of the aisle.
- Do not allow any part of your body to protrude out of the bus at any time.
- Wait for the bus in a quiet and orderly manner – including at bus interchanges.
- Stand away from the roadside until the bus comes to a complete stop.
- Wait until the bus stops before moving to get off the bus at your designated stop.
- Wait until the bus leaves the stop and you have clear vision before crossing the road.
- Cross the road where and when it's safe to do so, use crossings/traffic lights where available.

Legal considerations on buses:

- Wear the seat belt properly adjusted and fastened.
- Obey the law that bans smoking on buses
- Ensure that buses are not vandalised.
- Do not interfere with bus property, equipment, and signage.
- Do not leave rubbish on the bus, or at bus stops or interchanges.
- Ensure health regulations are followed as per Government directions, i.e CovidSafe Plan.

Using the bus:

- You will be provided an individual bus pass which is linked to the electronic manifest system in the bus
- Tap on using your bus pass upon boarding
- Do not lend your bus pass to other students or borrow from them.
- Bus fees are charged annually and will be invoiced separately to your tuition fees.

If you choose to use the **Dedicated School Runs** operated by Public Transport Victoria, your student must travel with a valid MYKI and there are no bookings required for this service.

How to get a Student Concession Card

MYKI application forms will be available from the College reception and on the website early in 2022

- i. Complete the application form supplying two legible passport sized photos.
- ii. Bring the form into the Front Office to be stamped and signed at the College.
- iii. Once signed and stamped, you are required to take it to Dandenong train Station with payment, where a Concession Card will be issued.

Students can choose to top up or purchase a yearly or half yearly pass to travel with their MYKI

PUBLIC TRANSPORT SERVICE IMPORTANT INFORMATION

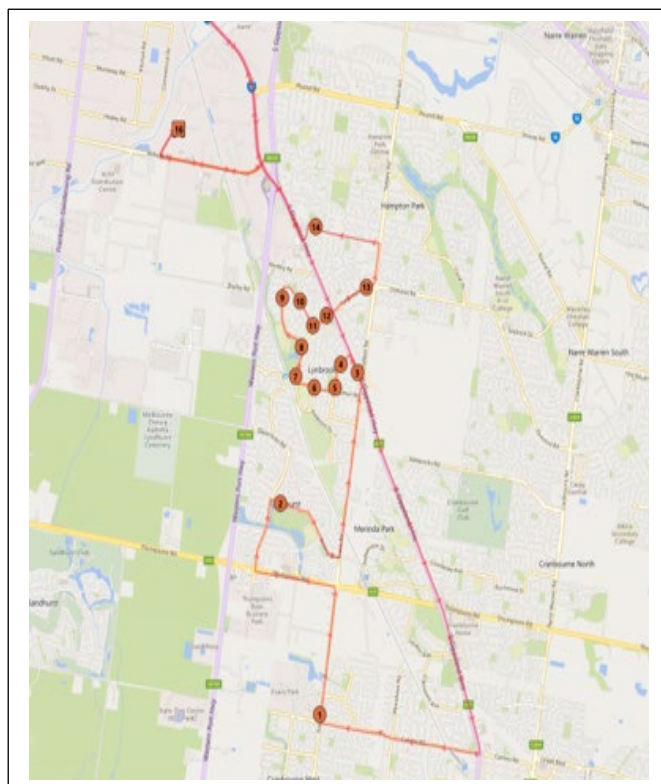
- No bookings required
- ALL Students travelling on a bus must be at the designated PTV stop at least 5 minutes prior to departure.
- The Dedicated School Run will follow the public transport route and the timetable is managed by Public Transport Victoria
- Students must always carry their valid MYKI as they will be required to produce the MYKI upon request by the Public Transport Inspectors or Ventura officers (bus operator).
- Students are eligible for an annual concession and MYKI application forms will be available from the College reception and on the website early in 2022
 - Complete the application form supplying two legible passport sized photos.
 - Bring the completed form into the Front Office to be stamped and signed at the College.
 - Once signed and stamped, you are required to take it to Dandenong Station with payment, where a Concession Card and Yearly Pass will then be issued.

IMPORTANT

- The College recommends that any student with anaphylaxis carry their own personal Epipen® and plan in their school bag, for use in an emergency while travelling to and from school.

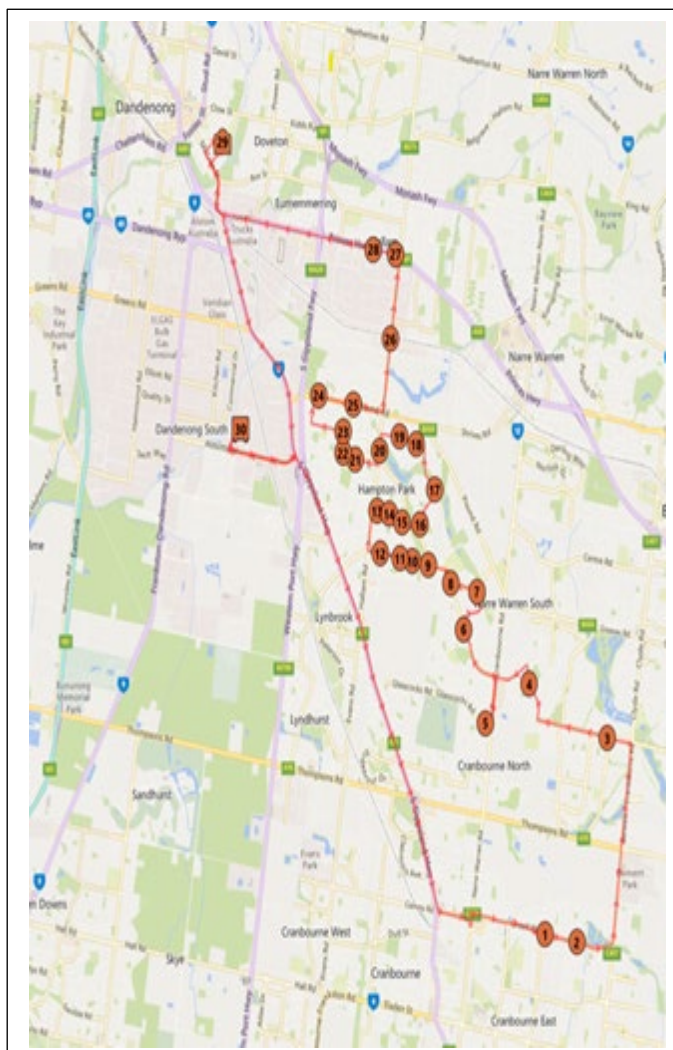

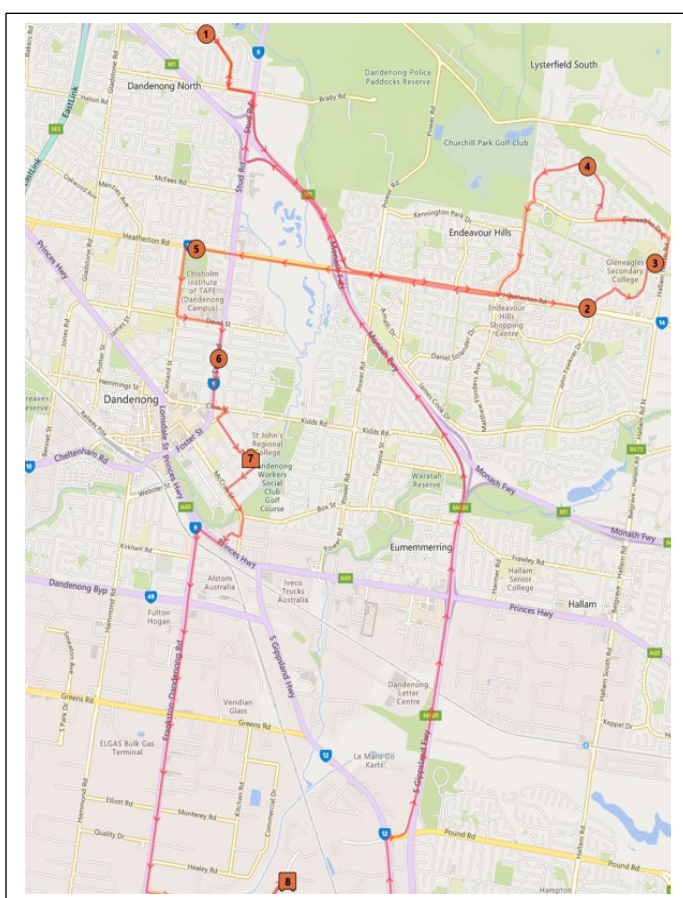

The timetable for this route will be developed based on the location of students that book on this bus.



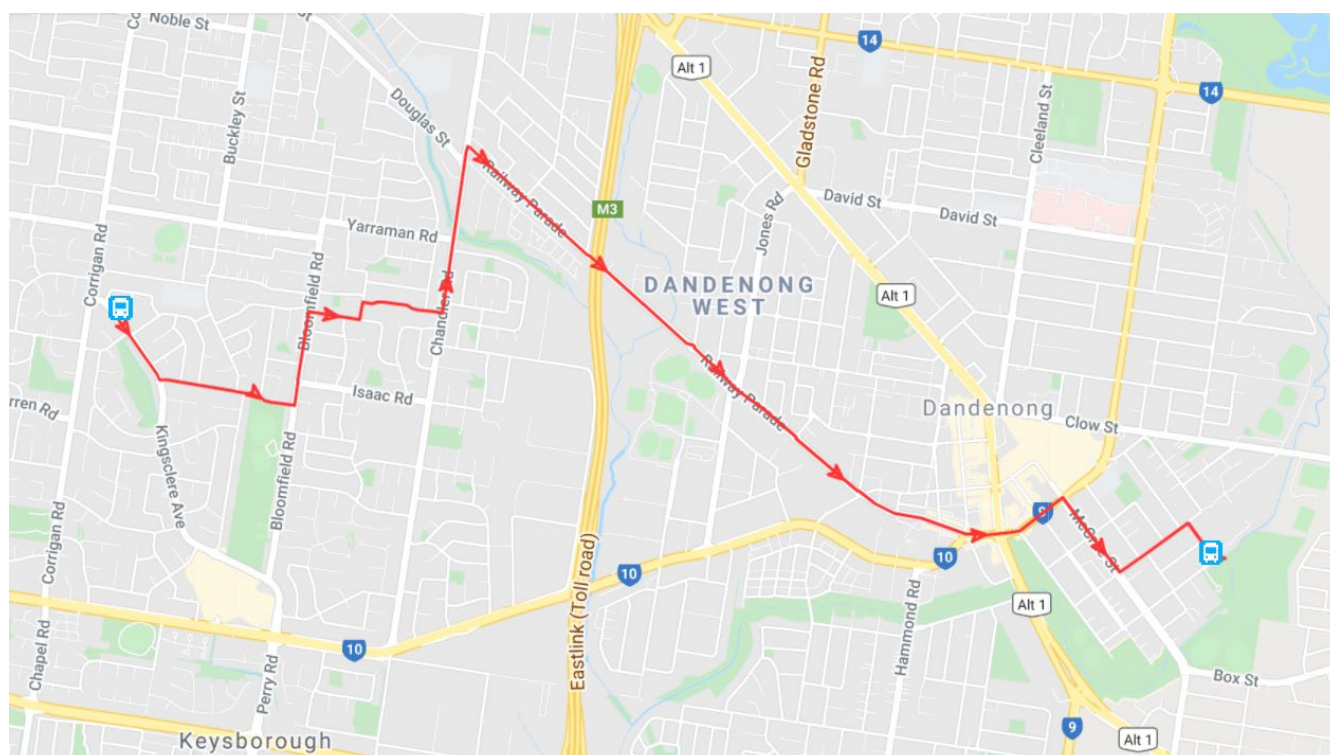
