TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- Applications are to be submitted annually via the reply slip before 20 October each year. Later applications will be processed upon receipt.
- Bus Passes will be issued at the start of the each
- Applications for travel are approved for a specific route and are not transferable.
- The Charter Bus fee is billed annually in November on the school account and is non-refundable.
- The full cost for the year becomes due and payable if a student ceases bus travel without notice.
- Non-payment of the Bus charge will result in cancellation of the Bus Pass.
- A replacement bus pass will incur a fee of \$5

STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT:

Students are expected to behave safely and responsibly at bus stops and while travelling and:

- Arrive at the bus stop 10 minutes early.
- Carry their bus pass card at all times as they will be required to tap on and off their bus.
- Respect the rights of other passengers and the bus driver.
- Must not distract the bus driver.
- Follow the instructions of the bus driver.
- Remain seated and use seat belts (legal requirement).
- Keep bus and bus stops free of litter.
- Keep the aisle clear of school bags and other obstructions.
- Travel only on their registered bus route.
- Behave in accordance with the college's policies and procedures.

Students will be suspended from using the Charter Bus service if it is deemed they are breaching the Conditions of Use
