UNIFORM

At St John's Regional College, our uniform symbolises unity, pride, and belonging. It reflects our high standards as a learning community and helps foster a safe and respectful environment.

This Uniform Handbook outlines our expectations regarding student dress, grooming, and presentation across all year levels. It has been designed to support students proudly wearing their uniform while promoting equality and school spirit. By following these guidelines, we ensure that every student contributes positively to our shared identity and represents St John's with dignity—both on and off campus.

SUMMER UNIFORM

The St John's Summer Uniform is to be worn during Terms 1 and 4.

Girls

- Dress – White ankle socks
- Navy trouser (optional) – navy socks
- Navy Short – white socks
- Overblouse with College crest short or long sleeved
- No tie
- Jumper (not to be worn as an outer garment to or from the College)
- Blazer
- Black plain leather/polishable lace-up or T-Bar school shoes (Mary Jane style shoes are not appropriate)
- College backpack

Boys

- Navy trousers – navy socks
- Navy shorts (optional) – white ankle socks
- Overshirt with College crest – short or long sleeved
- No tie
- Jumper (not to be worn as an outer garment to or from the College)
- Blazer
- Black plain leather/polishable lace-up school shoes (slip on style shoes are not appropriate)
- College backpack



WINTER UNIFORM

The St John's Winter Uniform is to be worn during Terms 2 and 3.

Girls

- Skirt – navy tights
- Navy trousers (optional) – navy sock or tights
- Overblouse with College crest – short or long sleeved
- Tie
- Jumper (not to be worn as an outer garment to or from the College)
- Blazer
- Black plain leather/polishable lace-up or T-Bar school shoes (Mary Jane style shoes are not appropriate)
- College Navy Beanie
- College backpack

Boys

- Navy trousers – navy socks
- Overshirt with College crest – short or long sleeved
- Tie
- Jumper (not to be worn as an outer garment to or from the College)
- Blazer
- Black plain leather/polishable lace-up school shoes (slip on style shoes are not appropriate)
- College Navy Beanie
- College backpack



PHYSICAL EDUCATION UNIFORM

Girls and Boys

- House Polo shirt
 - Navy PE shorts
 - White ankle socks
 - Navy Shell Jacket (compulsory for compulsory for all students enrolled in a PE subject)
 - Track pants (compulsory for all students enrolled in a PE subject)
 - College hat/cap/beanie
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Further Information

- Supportive lace-up running shoes – not slip-ons (sports shoes are permitted only during PE classes or for specified sporting events and activities)
- College utility bag
- Hair ribbons, headbands and hair clips must be the uniform navy blue, dark green or black (optional)
- Scarf – uniform navy blue, dark green or black (optional)
- Gloves – uniform navy blue, dark green or black (optional)

Hair

- Hairstyles should be natural and conservative
- For general presentation and demeanour, hair must be clean, off the face, and appropriately groomed
- The hair below the collar length must be tied back for safety and hygiene reasons
- Students are expected to be clean-shaven (no moustache or beard)
- **Hairstyles are to conform to the following guidelines:**
 - Hairstyle must be conservative and neat
 - Hair is not to be shaved less than grade 2
 - Hair colour must be natural, and no hair dye is permitted
 - Gel may be worn if it is used to hold a natural hairstyle in place
 - Plaits are acceptable but should not include beads
 - No dreadlocks or beads may be worn in the hair
 - Only navy blue, dark green or black hair ribbons may be worn
 - Hair clips or combs used to hold hair in place should be small and not of a vivid colour
 - No patterns or letters are to be cut into the hair
 - Failure to comply with the hair regulations may result in a student's suspension until the situation is rectified

Jewellery

Jewellery should be minimal. The only jewellery permitted with the uniform includes:

- One chain featuring a cross or another small Christian symbol
- One small ring
- One matching pair of plain, small sleepers or studs
- Official college badges

General Information

- Clothing must be kept in excellent condition, clean, well-pressed and labelled
- If an outer garment is to be worn to and from college, it must be the blazer
- Students participating in physical education camps or excursions must wear an approved college hat while outdoors, and it is recommended that all students do the same
- On days when they have a double PE lesson, all students must travel to and from the college and remain in their appropriate PE uniform all day. The only outer garment that can be worn in cold weather is the navy shell jacket or house rugby top. Blazers are not required on this day
- Students are encouraged to wear sunglasses in outdoor settings
- Students are encouraged to use sunscreen lotion (at least SPF30) outdoors
- Makeup, coloured nail polish and coloured lip gloss are not to be worn with the college uniform
- Soft-styled shoes without firm soles, slip-ons, and fashion shoes are inappropriate for the college environment

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
